

CHALLENGE CATEGORY INSTRUCTIONS

1) Category 700 – Charity Challenge

- Each participant chooses a kit of 4 fat quarters. 50% each fat quarter must be used on the front. The quilt must be at least 50x70 inches, and can be larger.
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place ribbons will be awarded on Saturday, April 3, 2027 at 3pm.
- Quilts will be donated to The Cridge Women's Transition House & Anney's Closet after the show.

2) Category 750 – Guild Challenge

- Theme: What We Use To Make A Quilt
- The wall hanging can be any shape up to 24” wide, and up to 24” long.
- Each participant is given 2 pieces of fabric (a 5” square, and a 5”x20” rectangle) – 50% of each piece must be used.
- The design must include a sewing machine and one or more other tools used to make a quilt.
- Any technique can be used to create and/or embellish.
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place ribbons will be awarded on Saturday, April 3, 2027 at 3pm.

3) Category 800 – Predisposed to UFO's

- An Unfinished Fabric Object from days gone by, partially started prior to 2026, and/or can include any/all of an orphan block collection.
- A before photo of a partially started Unfinished Fabric Object submitted before July 1, 2026
- The winner's prize will be awarded on Saturday, April 3, 2027 at 3 pm.

4) Category 900 – Youth Display aka Youth Quilting Contest

- Any Youth 18 and under can enter any size quilted item.
- It must be 3 layers – Top, Batting, Backing and have binding or be envelope turned.
- All Youth entries will receive a participation ribbon and 3 fat quarters.
- Prize Award UPDATE: Two youths will now be receiving prizes.
 - 1st place Youth winner will receive the grand prize (generously provided by the Cloth Castle).
 - 2nd place Youth winner will receive the second prize (generously donated by a benefactor)
- Prizes will be awarded Saturday, April 3, 2027 at 3 pm.
